

# Ocean Beach Pier Renewal Project



#### Overview

For more than 50 years, the Ocean Beach (OB) Pier has provided both locals and tourists with free access to fishing and other recreational activities. But recent storms and high surf have damaged the pier forcing it to close several times. A 2018 study of the pier analyzed three options for the future of the pier: repair, rehabilitate or replace. The study documented various structural problems with the pier and determined that it has reached the end of its service life. Based on this study, the City of San Diego determined that pursuing a potential replacement of the pier is the best option when considering return on capital investment, facility modernization, functional and operational improvements and design in anticipation of future sea level rise.

#### Ocean Beach Pier Renewal Project

The Ocean Beach Pier Renewal project aims to provide a preferred design alternative for the potential replacement of the OB Pier. The City contracted consultant Moffatt & Nichol to create the preferred design alternative, which will consider public input, community impact, environmental permitting, sustainability, operational usage, cost, historical significance and numerous other factors. The goal is for the potential replacement pier to have a service life of 75 to 100 years. An estimated cost for the project has not yet been determined, but a combination of federal and state grants is expected to help fund the project.

A task force was created to represent the community's interest in the project. The Ocean Beach Pier Task Force includes volunteer community members who were nominated by local advisory groups and representatives from Mayor Todd Gloria's office, Council District 2 and the City's Strategic Capital Projects Department.

#### **Seeking Public Input**

The City will be holding a series of community workshops to gather public input about the project. - Junior Lifeguards jump off the pier annually to raise funds for the Prevent Drowning Foundation of San Diego.

# **Community Partner Updates**



As many of you know, OBMA is a member of California Main Street/National Main Street. They are working on AB1669 which is working its way through the State Assembly. This would provide needed funding for local main streets and their individual businesses.

### **CAMS Calls for Your Support for AB 1669**

California Historically Significant Commercial District Act

AB 1669, introduced by Assemblywoman Sharon Quirk-Silva and Co-Author Senator Benjamin Allen, would create the California Historically Significant Commercial District Initiative. The bill will create a new state program for commercial corridor organizations like California Main Street to expand technical assistance services, conduct place-specific outreach, and connect your district's businesses to resources.

### **PROW Permits**

### PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY PERMITS

#### Public Right of Way Enhancement/Use Program (PROW)

The requirement of a PROW is now necessary after three-year non enforcement period due to COVID. Signage can only be in front of your business establishment and cannot be in front of a neighboring business or on the corner of an intersection.

#### What Is The PROW?

The PROW is a program that allows merchants more leeway and enlivens the pedestrian experience in our district by allowing merchants to use the sidewalks in front of their businesses for outdoor displays of merchandise, placement of A-frame signs, and outdoor cafés without railings without getting cited by the City's Code Compliance department.

#### Why Do We Need The PROW?

Signs, including A-frames, portables, and temporaries, are not permitted within the public right of way — except under the PROW Program. In other words, without this program businesses would not be allowed to place anything on the sidewalks. That is why your compliance is necessary for Ocean Beach businesses to continue to participate in this program. It is important to note that this does not give merchants a carte blanche to overtake their sidewalk. There are regulations which must be strictly enforced for this program to succeed. The good part about this is that the City is not involved in licensing merchants to use the sidewalk and charging costly fees. Before this program, outdoor dining required a permit and the placement of a metal barricade to separate tables and chairs from the sidewalk. The permits and the railings were costly. Thus, Merchants were effectively prohibited from placing chairs and tables outside their businesses. Also prohibited were the placement of signs on the sidewalk and display of goods and products outside their businesses.

#### Who Administers The PROW?

The City of San Diego PROW program is administered by the Ocean Beach MainStreet Association for a modest fee (\$78 per year) and is enforced by the City's Code Compliance Department. An annual permit is issued for display.
