Assembly Bill 1757

Assembly Bill 1757

We are happy to report that this bill that was making its way through the appropriations process at the State level, has been shelved or suspended for the time being. AB 1757 would have allowed and encouraged ADA lawsuits against those businesses who had websites in California. Literally, from the content providers to the owners of the websites, they all could have been sued if their websites didn't meet 100% of the current ADA best practices. This would apply to every page of a website. Many of us who represent small businesses jumped into action and started contacting elected officials, many of whom had no idea this was happening. Fortunately, AB1757 wasn't funded. We'll keep following it because the intention is to bring it back next year.

Sidewalk Vending Ordinance

Sidewalk Vending Ordinance saga continues . . .

On August 23rd two months after requesting a meeting with the Mayor and City Council Districts One and Two to discuss enforcement of the street vending ordinance the Coastal Coalition of community leaders from Ocean Beach, Mission Beach, Pacific Beach and La Jolla were granted a meeting. We met with Kohta Zaiser from the Mayor's office along with representatives from SDPD, Park Rangers, Parks & Rec personnel. It was a short meeting and we were told that the Sidewalk Vending Ordinance is being partially rewritten to close certain loopholes in the actual language. After that happens and is passed by the City Council, hopefully enforcement will be more robust. The Coastal Coalition is asking for expedited changes to the ordinance and immediate enforcement. The original ordinance does not include enforcement by SDPD which is a really important change that needs to be made.

We were made aware recently that Santa Monica has an ordinance that they are enforcing and have been enforcing for years. They also have day and night enforcement. We are urging the City and County (Environmental Health Dept.) to make sure that enforcement isn't just from 9 to 5pm. Most of our problems at the beaches happen after 5pm.









