OB SIGN with the help of the Ocean Beach Town Council, the Ocean Beach Community Development Corp. and the Ocean Beach Community Foundation. You might have noticed as you enter Ocean Beach along the Sunset Cliffs Blvd. corridor that the iconic Ocean Beach sign has seen better days. Not only has it been out there for over twenty seven years surviving the coastal climate, an army of termites seem to have taken up residence inside of it and it

could use a little tlc.

Local community groups have decided to enlist the community at large for re-design ideas. They put out a "Call for Artists" to see what might be possible to redo the sign.

We at OBMA, want to thank everyone for their feedback and spirited dialog about their fondness for the sign and ideas for the future. If, at the end of this public discussion, the community feels its best to re-create the original sign, then that could be the project. The call went out for public discussion for exactly this reason, to see how everyone felt.

# **NEWPORT AVENUE MAD NEWS**

Self-managed Maintenance Assessment Districts (MADs) differ from the City's Park & Recreation Department managed MADs in that a non-profit corporation (with a Board of Directors) contract for the management of the fund and enhanced goods and services. For the Newport Avenue MAD, the Ocean Beach MainStreet Association (OBMA) is the assigned non-profit.

Property owners along Newport Ave (4800-5000 blocks) are assessed a yearly fee that pays for things like trash collection, gardening, street cleaning, along with other repairs.

The City of San Diego and the selected non-profits annually enter into a service agreement whereby the non-profit agrees to assume complete responsibility for the provision of enhanced goods and services to assessment district property owners. In the last year, some self-managed MAD's have banned together to discuss how these entities are overseen by the City.

Self-managed MAD's in San Diego include the Ocean Beach, Little Italy, Hillcrest, College Area, Adams Avenue, City Heights, Central Commercial, and Bird Rock. The above representatives met with the Mayor, City Attorney, Office of Small Business and the Economic Development Department under the Business Improvement District Council Maintenance Assessment District Committee (BIDC MAD). The OBMA Board of Directors recently took action to support implementing a San Diego Council Policy to address common contractual issues amongst self-managed MADs including: contract terms, release of funds, City administrative fees, and liability issues concerning the public right-of-way. The group hopes to go before the City's Public Safety & Neighborhood Services committee in September of this year to continue these discussions. 
