READY TO LAUNCH

We are launching the **Ocean Beach Security Program as of June 3rd.** We will meet with the security staff, sign our contract with them and map out the first week's plan. The patrol will begin June 10th.

This 3 month pilot program has been created by the OBMA's Crime Prevention Committee with much involvement from the OB Town Council and interested community members.

The intent of the program is to preserve the familyfriendly nature of Ocean Beach by enhancing public safety for residents, property owners, businesses, visitors and tourists through an increased security presence in an effort to eradicate bad behavior and criminal acts.

The hired security patrols will bike and walk the commercial areas that are most impacted by crime and quality of life issues. This program is funded through the generous support of members business, property owners, and residents with a portion of funds coming from the Newport Avenue Maintenance Assessment District.

The Security Patrol will operate out of the OBMA-funded Police Trailer in the Pier Parking lot. Their hours will vary and will change often. Weekly reports will be kept and data analyzed. At the end of the 3 month pilot program, stakeholders will work together to assess the successes of the program and determine the future of the OB Security Program going forward.




