The Ocean Beach Woman's Club has been a "Hub of Activity" in Ocean Beach for 88 years. The majority of the club's history from 1924 to 1937 has been lost from the official records. The information that we do have comes from historians and newspaper articles of the time. On September 21, 1997 the building sustained major fire damage. Again much of the club's records and history was lost or damaged by the fire. It is gratifying that the sons and daughters of old time members are finding and presenting the club with memorabilia of the club in years past. The Ocean Beach Woman's Club was founded on November 24, 1924, and is one of the oldest civic groups in San Diego. Forty five charter members are listed as having signed the charter. . . . Report your employee count

accurately on Business Tax Certificate

"The city's businesses are no longer *on the honor system* regarding their number of employees as" reported in a story about Business Taxes according to Rachel Laing from the Mayor's Office. "As part of the Fiscal Year 2011 budget process, the City Treasurer implemented the Business Tax Employee Verification Program. This program requires small businesses to submit tax documentation that would allow the city to confirm a businesses' self-reported employee count and validates that a business is correctly reporting its number of employees.

Prior to implementing the Employee Verification Pro-

Also, if you run a business or own commercial property in the neighborhood, please take a minute to make sure your Police Authorization Letter (SDPD Letter of Agency) is up to date, as you have to renew it every six months.

Also, if you have an Android cell Phone or iPhone you can download the app San Diego 311 and upload photographs of your concerns directly to a site the city interacts with. gram businesses were audited by the City's Revenue Audit Division during hotel TOT audits or upon request. This was not cost effective to spend audit staff time auditing a \$34 business tax assessment. The Employee Verification Program is a low-cost

way for the city to conduct compliance checks on businesses to ensure businesses are correctly reporting its number of employees. To date this program has brought in an additional \$20,000 in business tax revenue. The verification of employee count is currently being done randomly or triggered by a public complaint. A business that under-reports will be liable for correct amount of business taxes owed minus taxes paid to the city. The previous year unpaid taxes are also assessed a penalty charge of 1% per month and a \$250.00 non-compliant surcharge."




