Your City of San Diego business tax certificate must be current for your business to be included in the OB Local Business Directory. Each year, businesses must renew their certificate. Please call Denny if you have any questions at 619-224-4906



If you change your business address, close your business, or sell your business, you are required to provide a written notification to the City of San Diego about the change. The easiest way to report a change in

your business tax account is to email the information to: btax@sandiego.gov New owners must file a new application either in person (City of SD, Downtown location), via mail, or online. That information may be accessed at: http://www.sandiego.gov/treasurer/taxesfees/btax/btaxhow.shtml




