

City of San Diego to upgrade water system in OB

The City of San Diego has announced that the water system in Ocean Beach will be upgraded in the coming months. The improvements include the replacement of outdated cast iron water mains that have reached the end of their service life. These mains will be replaced with state-of-the-art materials that are far more resistant to deterioration and breaks. The estimated start time in Dec. 1, 2009 ending on Jan. 4, 2011.

The commercial areas affected include Abbott St. at Santa Monica Ave., Abbott St. at Muir, and Sunset Cliffs Blvd from Voltaire to Brighton Ave. Long Branch and Abbott St. will be most affected by the construction along the residential corridor. There will also be a lot of construction on Greene St., Larkspur and Seaside.

Signs will be posted as the City works on the construction. During the summer months there will be no construction. If you have further questions, please contact www.sandiego.gov/water/cip/group.shtml and select "frequently asked questions about group jobs."

During the <u>OB Parade</u>... Please make sure you leave your lights on to give your business needed exposure. OBMA worked with the City to make sure Newport Avenue could stay open for parking until 3pm. Please remind your customers so they don't get a ticket or a tow.
