

A Christmas Message

From Reverend Thomas Ziegert

Times have been tough on almost all of us. Unlike too many other places, we in OB know that we're in this together. We know that we need times to share together, to celebrate together, to realize how strong we are, how resilient we are, how much hope we have, how much faith we have together. This Christmas season we will have many opportunities to be together to remember who we are and what it is we seek together. You are invited to celebrate who we are and what we believe in as our business community is supported and as we support and embrace our neighbors and faith. You are invited to support one of the several churches here in OB, just like you would a business. Join with your neighbors, business owners and patrons sharing something deeper and more primal this Christmas – hope and faith.

Each of the churches here in OB reflects some aspect of this community, its core values, its hopes and its beliefs. Each is different but each is an integral part of what it means to be from OB. Find your way to any one this Christmas and you will find renewal.

Of course if you should pick Point Loma United Methodist Church, you should know that our worship services start at 10:30 a.m. and that there is a 20 minute musical improv before worship begins that is open to the public with no expectation that anyone stay to worship. It's a great way to start a Sunday. There's a monthly "First Friday Feast" (not always on the 1st Friday – so call to confirm) that is great food, fun and fellowship for just \$5 per person or \$15 per family. That's at 6:30 p.m.
