Business Tax and Rental Unit Business Tax assessments can be paid online. It's convenience to pay online, it's <u>no cost to use the</u> <u>service</u>, and prevents delays in the posting of payments. Payment types accepted include Credit Card (MasterCard, Visa), ACH checking, and ACH savings. You will be required to enter your account number, which can be found on your bill or by contacting the Business Tax Division at (619) 615-1500. From Reverend Thomas Ziegert
