

The National Trust recently launched ShopMainStreet.org, a national portal to Main Street retail businesses that have an **online retail component** - whether full-fledged e-commerce or simply an online catalog - and will allow visitors throughout the country to shop online at the unique shops that make Main Streets great.

Business Listing Criteria: In order to qualify for ShopMain-Street.org, retail businesses must be located in a "Main Street" or other traditional commercial district and must have ecommerce capabilities. This can be either a full fledged online ordering and payment system or simply a product listing with clearly marked price and ordering information. They want to try and keep the consumer experience on ShopMainStreet.org as positive as possible so they will review the listings and reserve the right to remove any that they feel does not meet their requirements.
