What to do when you are hit with graffiti!

Bryan Hewitt, SDPD, wanted to restate the procedures for graffiti:

1st. GRAFFITI CRIME IN PROGRESS...911

2nd GRAFFITI ON PROPERTY no suspect....

531-2000. Tell dispatch you need a report. A telephone report will be sufficient if you have a way to email photos of the vandalism. Tell dispatch that you do not want the graffiti hotline.

3rd Take photos of the graffiti if you can. Photos can be sent, picked up, dropped off, mailed, emailed, etc. Bryan's email is:

4th If you take photos of property that is not yours, please make sure to put the time you noticed it, the location (address), and the person's name who took the photos.

5th Once photos are taken...even if it's 5 minutes after an incident, you can REMOVE the graffiti. 6th FOR GRAFFITI ON CITY OF SAN DIEGO PROPERTY...619 525-8522. This is a MESSAGE PHONE, leave the location of the vandalism and they usually clean it within a few days.

7th FOR GRAFFITI ON PRIVATE PROPERTY... direct people to the URBAN CORP....**1-800-829-6884**. This is also a MESSAGE phone. Please make sure you CONSIDER a letter of authorization if it's YOUR property.

8th If you have graffiti clean-up privately done please obtain a receipt or cost assessment for the damages. This can be attached to your crime case for possible future prosecution.



Cabrillo National Monument Celebrates National Trails Day –June 5th

(San Diego, California) Cabrillo National Monument will participate in the 2010 National Trails Day on Saturday, June 5, 2010 at Cabrillo National Monument, San Diego's National Park, by hiking the Bayside Trail and participating in the park's Junior Ranger Programs. The scenic Bayside Trail is a moderate, 2.5 mile (roundtrip) trek that winds through remnant coastal Mediterranean habitat, one of the most threatened habitat types in the world, while descending 300 feet from the 19th century Old Point Loma Lighthouse to trail's end, 90 feet above sea level. The Bayside Trail affords spectacular vistas of the San Diego Bay and the cities beyond. Young people of all ages are invited to participate in the park's Junior Ranger Program. The National Park Service (www.nps.gov) is a partner with the American Hiking Society (www.americanhiking.org). Cabrillo National Monument, located on Point Loma at the end of Catalina Boulevard, is open daily from 9:00 AM until 5:00 PM, while the Bayside Trail closes at 4:00 PM.
