

our efforts and work to perfect our Security Program. We have also applied for an \$8,000 CPPS grant through our Councilman Ed Harris to help extend the time frame and to supplement the funds raised from our members. Here are some things we have learned about the program in just the first 2 months:

- Security members made 418 contacts (1.56 contacts per hour)
- 8 more major incident reports were written up
- 75% of issues were Code 647 (Disorderly conduct including loitering on private property, drunk in public, and illegal lodging on private property)
- Other common issues included blocking the sidewalk, aggressive solicitation, and dogs without leashes.
- There are approximately 25 "regular" repeat offenders
- We had 268 hours of coverage patrolling up to Dog Beach and the Voltaire area and down to Narragansett with majority of time in the downtown area.
- In mid July, security started reporting and dealing with 22 large items like sofas and they also cleaned up 11 taggings.
- Busiest days are Wed & Friday nights.
- 1 dog was found and reunited with owner, 1 lost child was reconnected with parents, and one chronic bad behaviorist was taken in by a group in Venice

We also learned that we need a few more hours of coverage per day and possibly one more day of patrolling to be even more effective. The bike patrol has been very helpful in identifying areas that need to be cleaned up (illegal dumping of sofas, chairs, building materials, junk and so on). We've learned more about some of our chronically bad behaviorists through personal contact and it should continue to translate into less problems as we go forward. It is also important that our security officers have identifiable uniforms and also visit with local business owners on a regular basis. As always, we look to our members for suggestions and participation in the OB Security Program.

We will be contacting our membership about renewing our crime prevention efforts so that we can continue this very successful program.
